



2017 Enduro Rules

1. Only rear wheel drive or front wheel drive vehicles allowed. Four wheel and all wheel drive vehicles can be used as long as one driveshaft is removed. No full size trucks or vans.
2. All glass, moldings, door handles, headlights, taillights and exterior chrome must be removed. This includes headlight mount panels. Anything that can fall off on the track must be removed. No foreign objects attached to the roof. Roof number plates must be collapsible if used.
3. Fuel tanks cannot remain under the vehicle unless it is front of the rear axle. All tanks shall be securely strapped into the trunk or rear most portion of the vehicle. Must be fastened with at least (2) 1/8" x 1" flat steel straps and (4) 1/2" bolts. No plumbers tape, fabric or chains.
4. Batteries can be in stock position or moved as long as they are mounted with steel straps and bolts. All batteries must be covered.
5. Radiator must remain in stock position. Tranny coolers must not be mounted in passenger compartment.
6. Front and rear bumpers are mandatory and must be securely mounted. Collapsible shocks can be welded, do not reinforce bumper. All bumpers must be chained with two chains so they can not fall off on the track.
7. No mud, snow or all-terrain type tires on the drive axle.
8. Each person must wear an approved helmet with eye protection and also wear a functional seat belt. Also long sleeve shirts.
9. Rubbing and hugging allowed. No intentional hits, violators will receive penalty. Get hurt
10. No person will exit from any vehicle during the event unless a red flag has been displayed by officials. If vehicle is dead on a red you may exit your vehicle only to go to the pits. No repairs of any kind on red or yellow flags.
Vehicles may be worked on at half time. If vehicle is running Stay in it and keep your helmet on and seat belts fastened at all times.
11. Each vehicle is responsible for providing a lap counter. This person shall work in the main grandstand and score each lap using a system approved by the judging staff.
12. Any unsportsmanlike or disruptive conduct will result in immediate disqualification with no refund of entry fee.
13. No alcoholic beverages of any kind in the pits.
14. All trailer hitches must be removed.

15. Flags will be discussed at the drivers meeting. Any driver not in compliance with the flag orders may be subject to waiting one lap in the pits or center of the track. For example a red flag on the track means stop immediately. If you continue to proceed to the pits from the track you will wait one full lap when the race resumes.

16. You MUST drive slowly through the pit area. There are lots of people, movement and noise. Someone could easily get hurt in this situation. Any driver to be found to be driving through the pit area will be held at the gate by the official for one full lap before they can resume the race.

17. All safety gear must be in proper working order. Helmets must have an operating chin strap; seat belts must be in working condition and safety harnesses. If used, must be installed properly.

18. All doors must be welded or chained shut. Chains must be a minimum of 3/8" with nut and bolt secure. No light weight chain will be allowed.

19. Trunks: If your gas tank is located in the trunk you are required to chain your trunk shut, minimum of one chain 3/8". If your gas tank is located in front of your rear axle you are allowed to bolt your trunk shut minimum 3/8" bolts.

20. Hoods: hoods will be chained with 3/8" chain minimum.

21. Once the race is completed all participants will be expected to come to the track to help pick up any debris. **NO CHECKS OR TROPHIES WILL BE ISSUED UNTIL THE TRACK OFFICIAL HAS DEEMED THE TRACK CLEAN!**

22. All body parts must remain inside the car at all times! Please do not reach outside to fix something while the race is going.

23. Each car must carry a red flag in the car approximately 4" x 5", to wave at the flagman in case of emergency. Flags can be purchased at the track for \$1.00
